### Frequently Asked Questions

How do teachers receive assistance? Teachers can arrange for reimbursement (for the cost of poster board only, not other materials) by:

1. Contacting the Contest organizers requesting assistance. Funding will be available on a limited, first-come, first serve basis.
2. Submit copy of receipt for cost of poster board when submitting posters. Reimbursement request should conform with quantity of posters submitted. Be sure to include contact and mailing information.

Why are the contest posters donated? The proceeds of the silent auction will be used to support the Peace Projects of the Committee. (The Contest organizers will ensure that ALL student posters will receive at least the minimum bid of \$5.00.)

What kind of activities will the proceeds support? To date, these projects have included: peace education in schools, scholarships for families on the Carteret Atoll (Papua New Guinea), tuition assistance for online classes in Global Studies (with a peace theme), a teen conference on anti-bullying, and Peace Gardens in local schools.

Do winners have to be present? No, but all artists and their families are encouraged to join the community and to be among the thousands in attendance at the parade and festival on Sunday, September 21 in Honokaa.
