Deadline for submission: September 14, 2008, 5:00 p.m. Contact the Contest organizers for details on location.

Prizes: First and Second prizes (\$50 and \$25) for each grade level, K-12. Grand Prize for "Best in Show" – One night stay for winner and parents at Waianuhea Bed & Breakfast, Ahualoa, Big Island (minimum value \$200).
