Vendors shall provide all equipment, labor, materials, (banner, signage, vehicles, tables, chairs, generators, trash bins, etc.), prepare for inclement weather, display all required licenses and documents, and clean up their area before leaving.
- e) No cooking unless you have a permit from the fire department.
