1. **Acceptance of this application and eventual participation in events will be at sole discretion of the Committee, indicated by signature below.**
2. Participation must be in good taste and not offensive, and not contradict the values of peace, compassion and inclusiveness.
3. Parade entrants are encouraged to meet production and technical challenges (visual and audio) of performing outdoors as part of a "moving stage." This could include a quality, outdoor p.a. system.
4. All participants must check in to Parade line-up at the staging area by no later than **10:00 a.m.** on the day of the Parade.
5. Each entry will provide a brief narrative to be read by our Announcer (30 words OR LESS), which is subject to editing. Form is on website, [www.peacedayparade.org](http://www.peacedayparade.org) – ("Participate / Parade Entrants Info")
6. All organizations are expected to respect and honor participants who hold opposing views.
7. Organizations may be asked to participate in a follow-up evaluation of the activities.
8. Organizations will be responsible for cleaning their assigned areas (starting and ending points of parade)
9. Organization may be asked to agree in writing to various Terms & Conditions as will be provided by the Committee in the future.
